Jan became a Director in accordance with Clause 29 of the RDA (NSW) Constitution as an Appointed Director.

Ian became a Director in accordance with Clause 32.3 of the RDA (NSW) Constitution to fill a Casual Vacancy in the position of an Elected Director.
