Questions & Answers

Why are we filling out a new Centre Delegation form?

There are two key reasons:

- 1. This Delegation Form is being made under the proposed new Constitution which will considered by the Member Centres on 11th November.
- 2. It also includes an email address that will be used by your Centre Delegate to vote for new Directors

It is important that you fill out the Centre Delegation Form for the SGM to be held on the 11th of November **AND ALSO** this Centre Delegation Form, as they are different.

Why are we receiving this form when the new Constitution has not yet been approved by the Centre Members?

This is mainly to do with timing.

We wanted to minimise the amount of time after the SGM on 11 November until the election of new Directors.

Why are we being asked to provide an email address for the Election of Directors?

At the 2nd SGM to be held on 25 November 2024, your Centre Delegate will be asked to fill out an online ballot for the Election of the new Directors.

This process will allow for simpler, quicker and more accurate counting of the votes.

The email address should be one that the Centre Delegate can access while they are online at the meeting. It is perfectly constitutional if the email address is their personal email address, so long as that is what is submitted on the Centre Delegation Form.
