
SUMMARY OF PROBLEMS WITH CURRENT CONSTITUTION

USE ACNC CONSTITUTION TEMPLATE HAVE 6 - 9 DIRECTORS WITH 3-YEAR TERMS. 1/3 RESIGN EACH YEAR

3 - 5 CLEAR CHARITABLE 'OBJECTS' IN LINE WITH ACNC RECOMMENDATIONS REVERT BACK TO NORMAL FINANCIAL YEAR I.E. 1ST JULY TO 30TH JUNE
